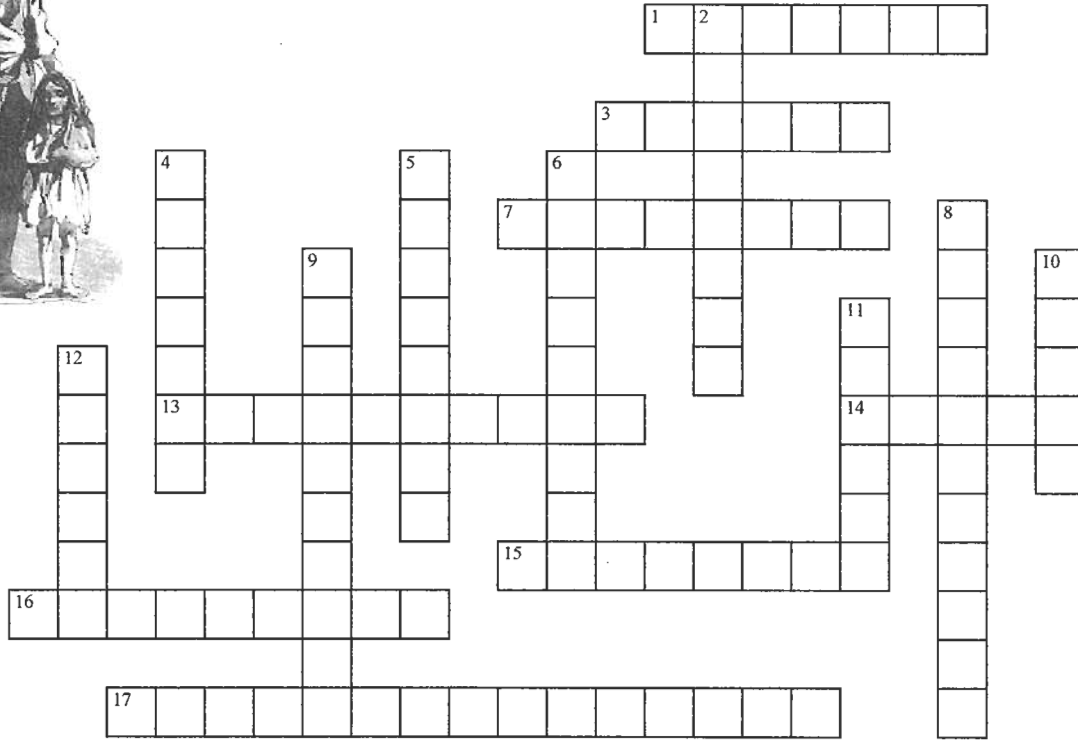




Ireland's Great Hunger
